6 Teams / 1 Heat

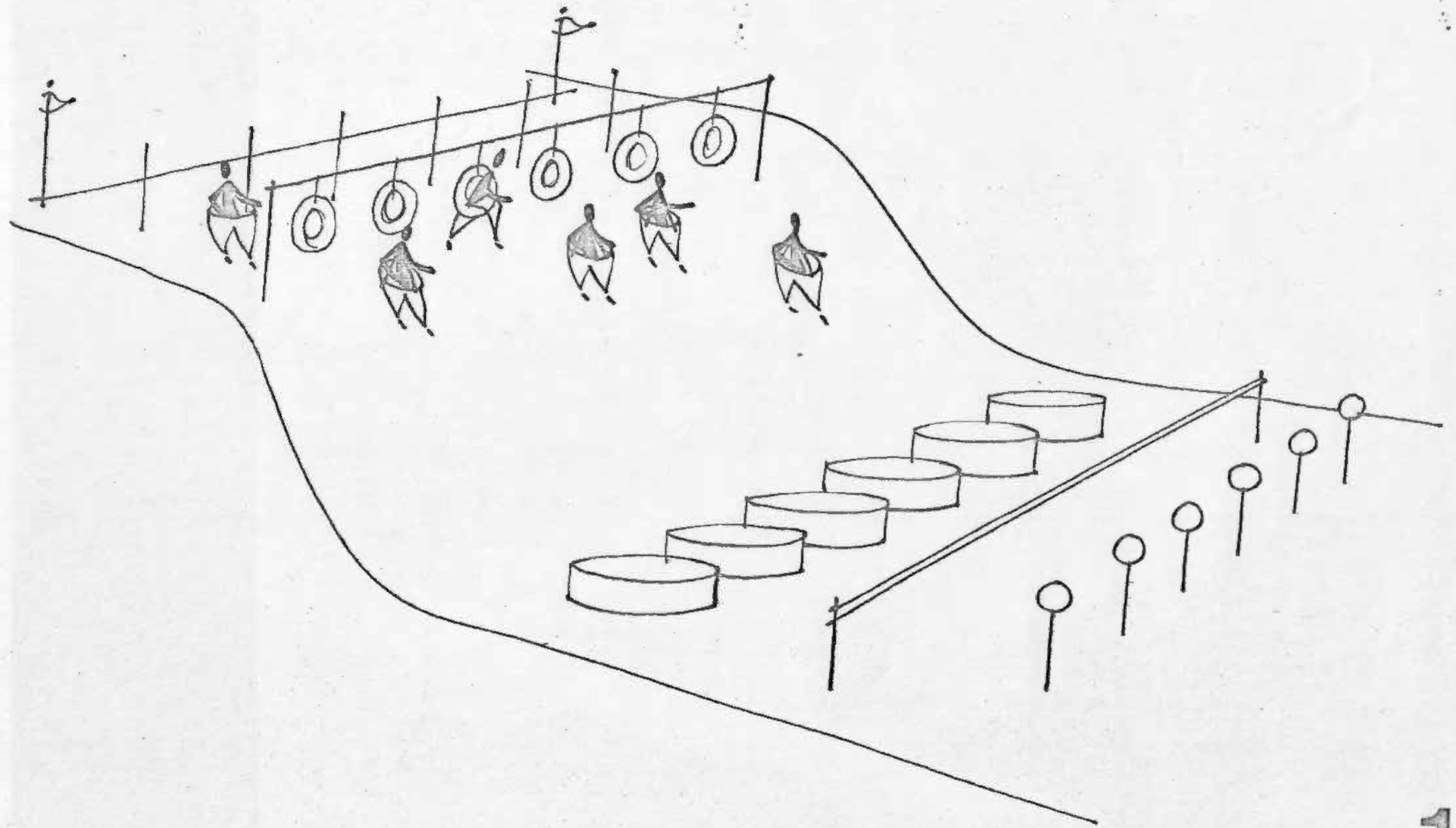
1 Male.

One man stands inside a number of inner tubes, wearing a pair of oversize trousers over them.

At whistle, he progresses from start line, through a hoop, down a slope, into a pool, out and under a low tape. He turns round a stand, bursting a balloon on the top of it and returns up course negotiating the same hazards. At the top of the course, he turns round a vertical post and comes back to finish, going through the same hazards.

The winning team will be the first to finish.

GAME 2: BROLLEY BALL

3 Teams / 2 Heats

3 Males / 2 Females plus Lady Captain

One girl takes a ball from an area supplying all teams playing and climbing on to her allotted area of an air tube, throws the ball, aiming over a bar, so that it is caught in the centre of four opened umbrellas being held by three men and one girl from her team.

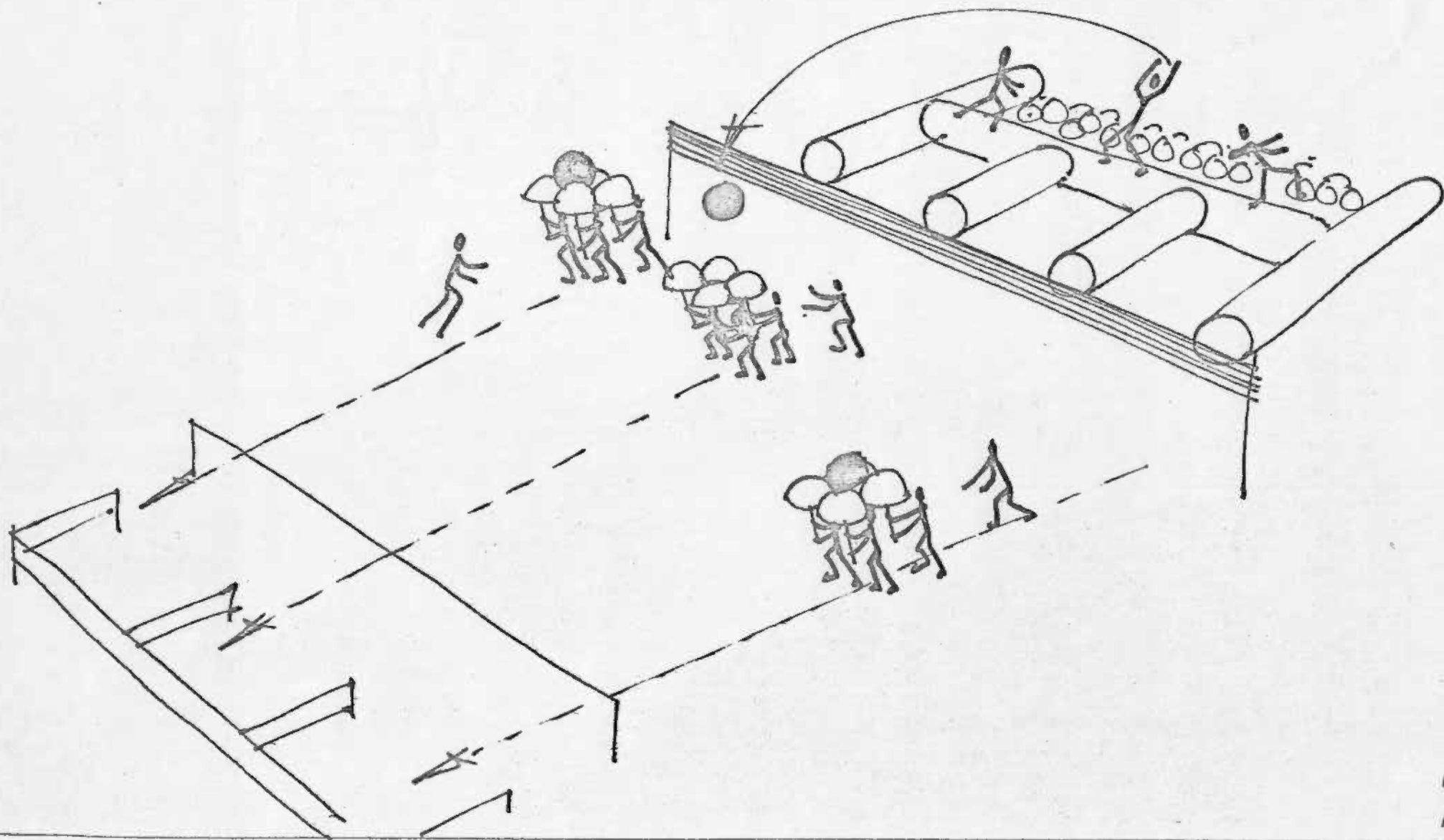
Thus caught the ball is transported over the course where they go under a low tape, and tip the ball into a collecting box.

They return the same way to catch another ball. The Lady Captain walks alongside the 'brolley holders to replace the ball if it falls off, although she may not assist after the low tape has been negotiated.

The winning team will be the one with most balls correctly caught and deposited in their collecting box.

2 Teams / 3 Heats

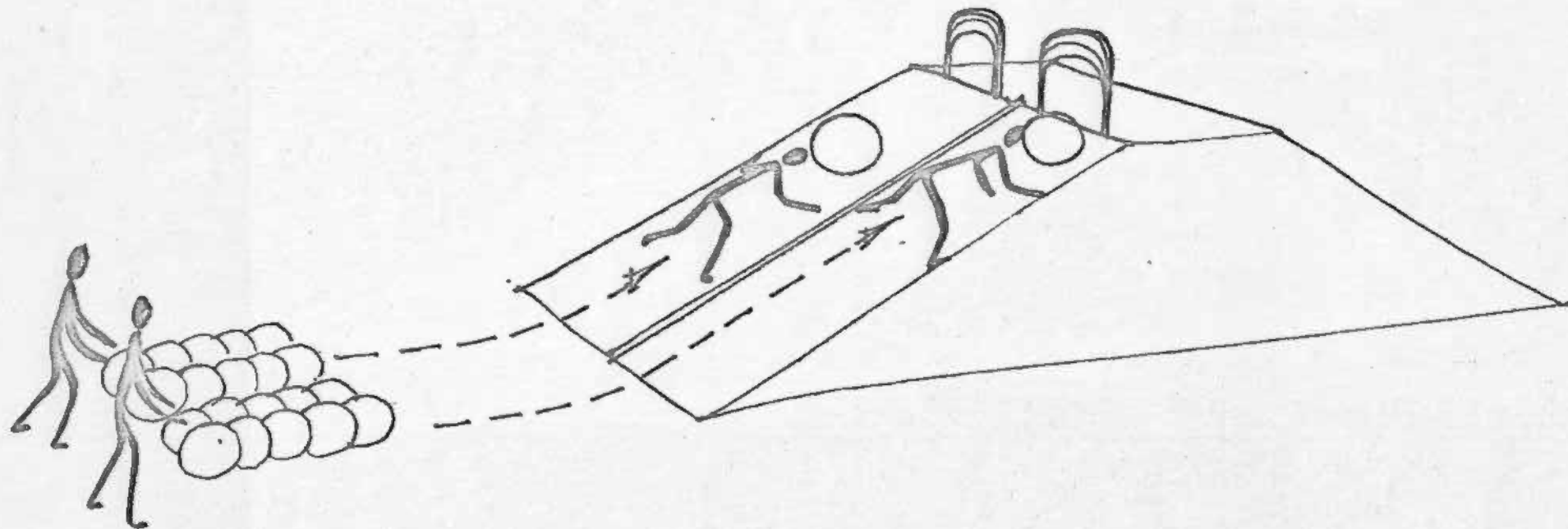
2 Males

3 Teams / 2 Heats

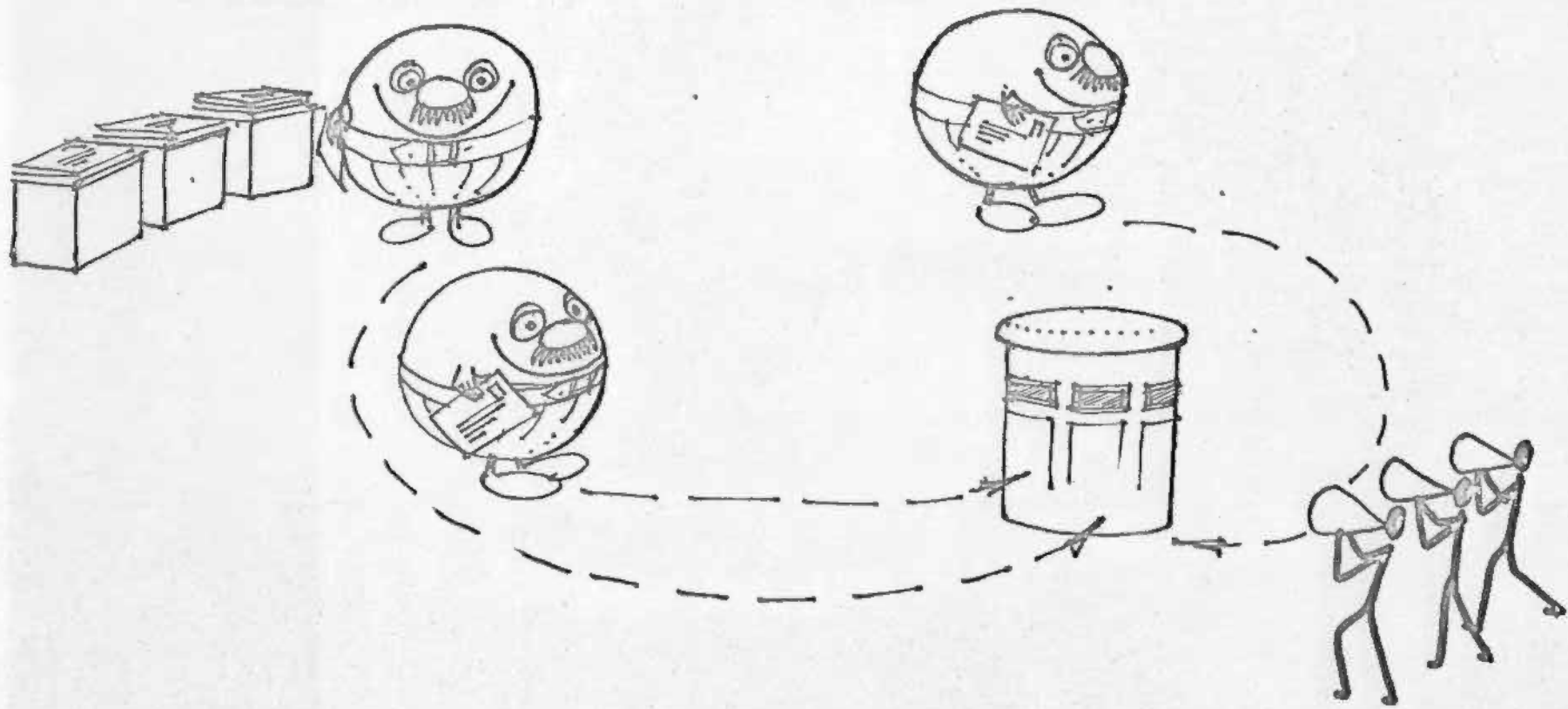
1 Male / 1 Female

2 Males / 2 Females

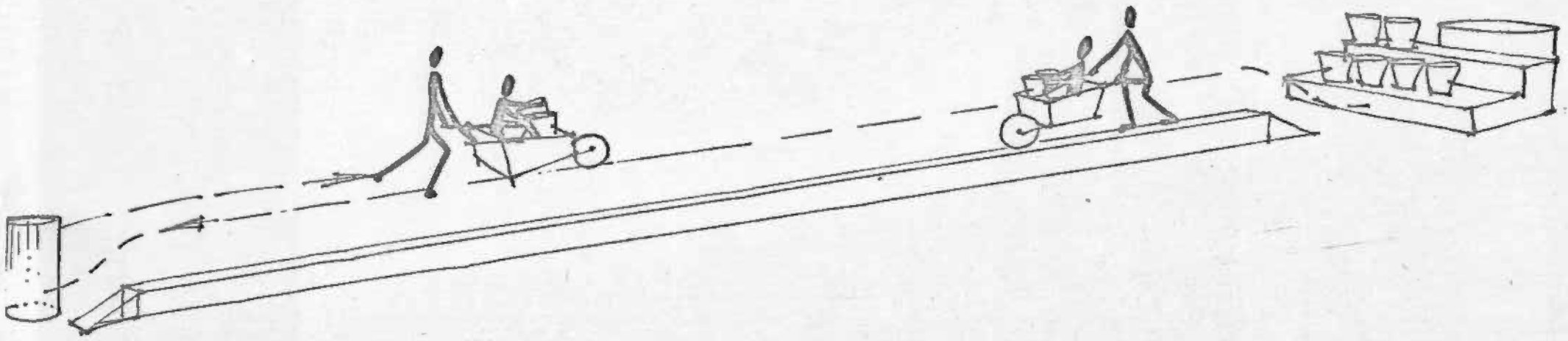

After the buckets are emptied they return to the start over the ground, leaving the track clear for the next couple in their team to go.

They transport all the pre-loaded buckets first, then fill their own from a large water drum.

The winning team will be the one with most water collected within the time limit.

1 Male / 1 Female

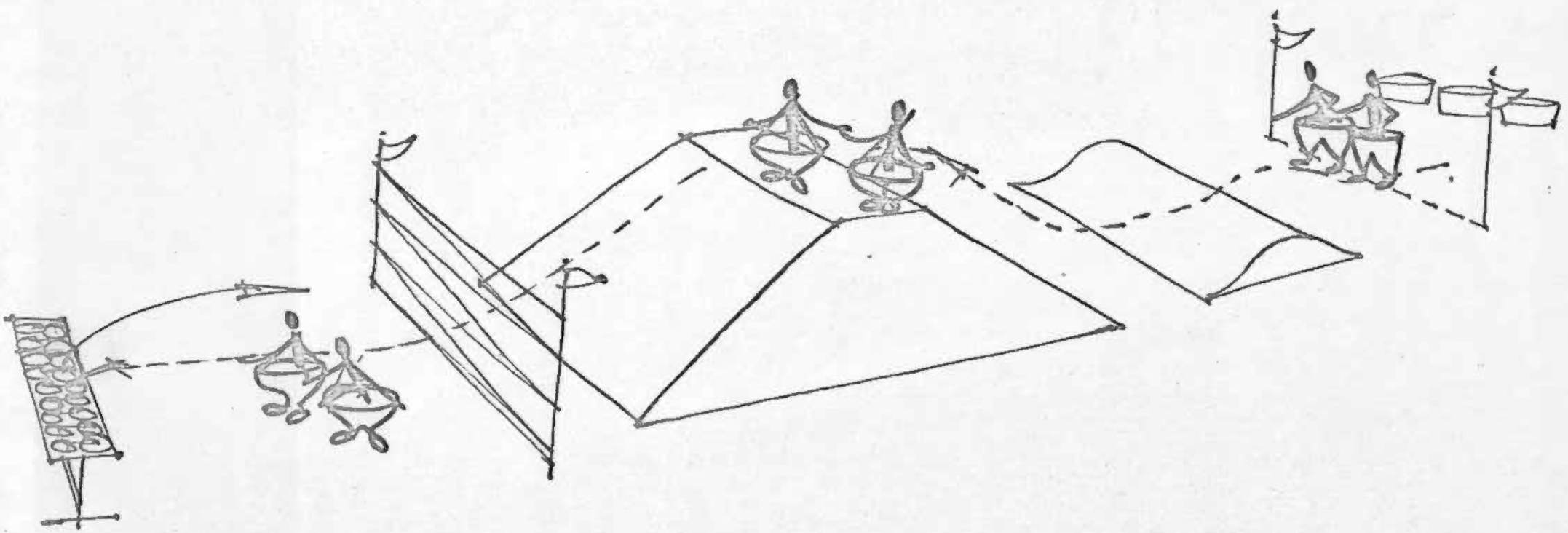

1 Male / 2 Females

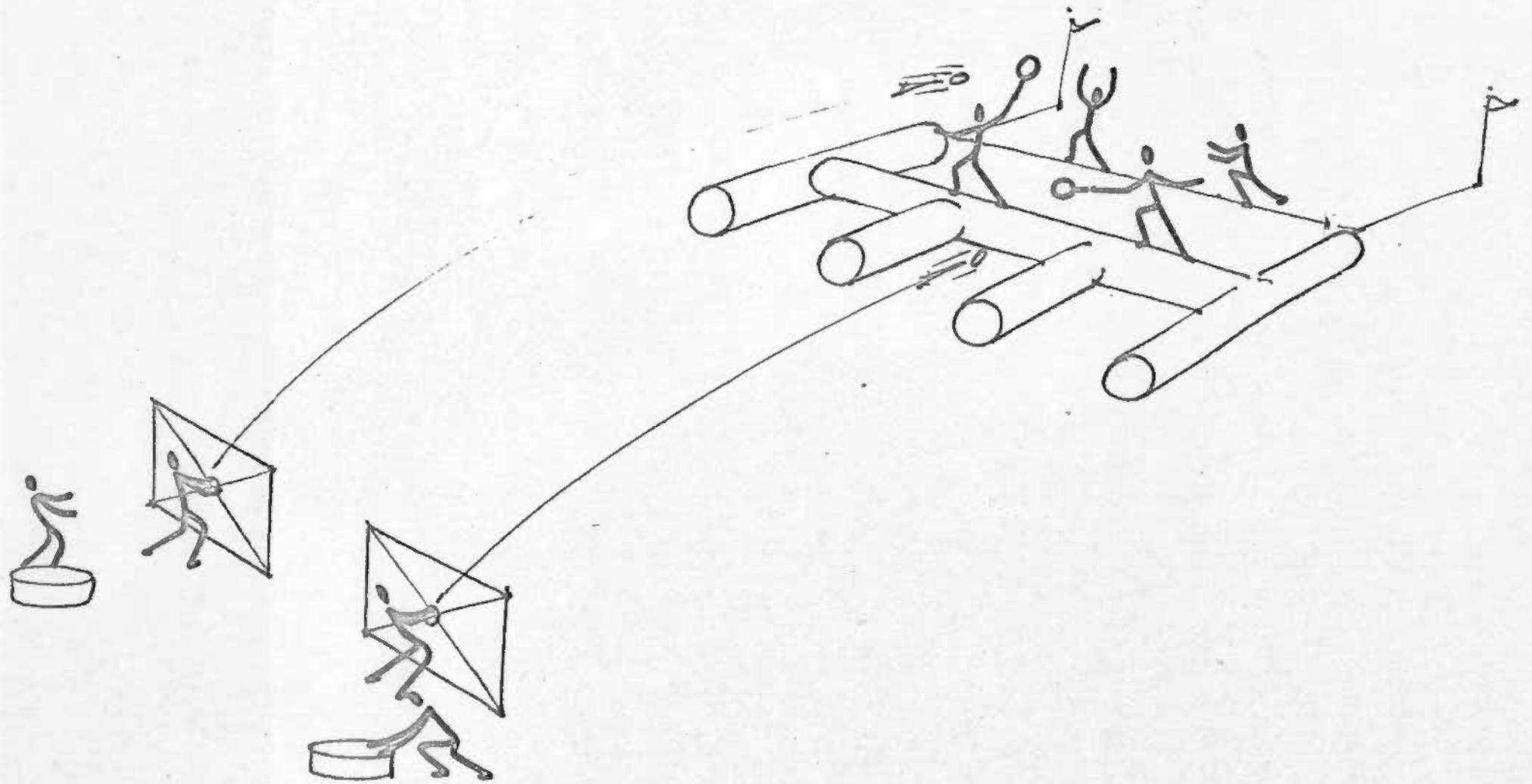
1 Female in Opposition

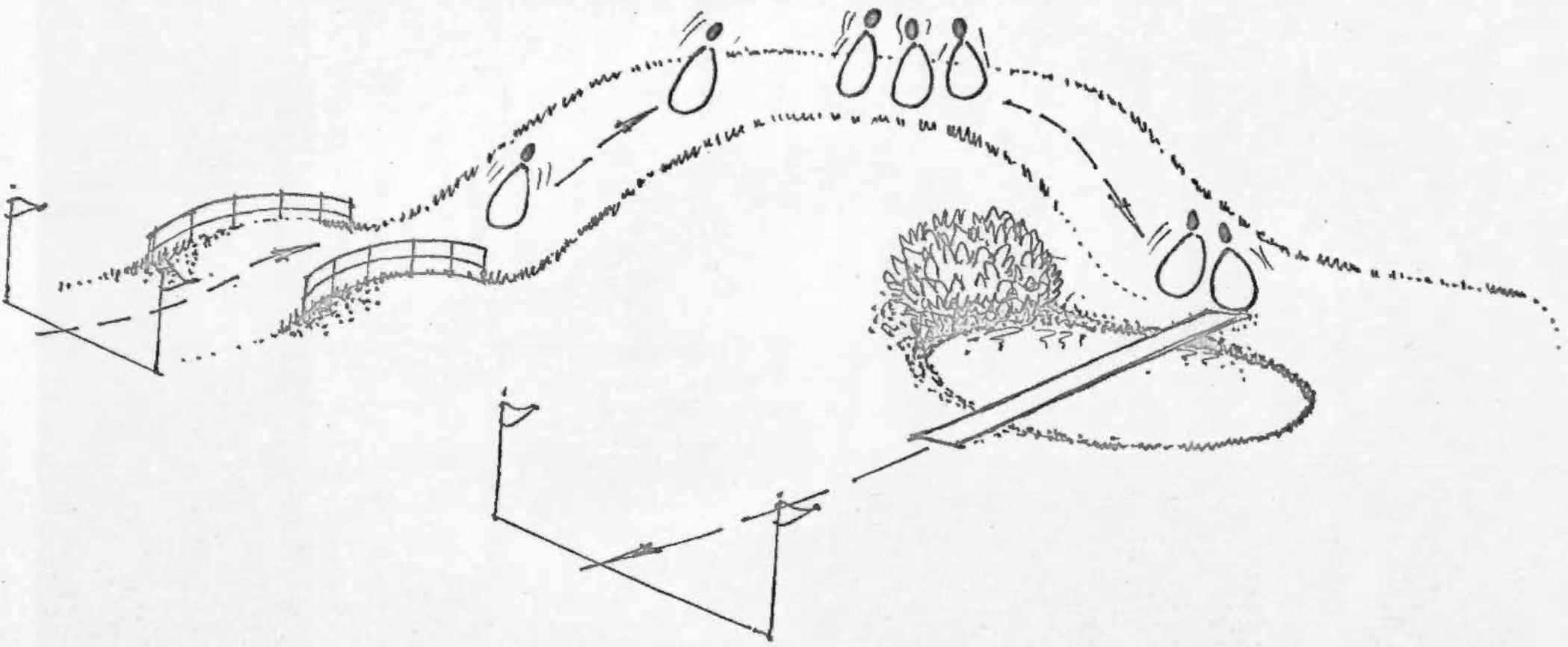
GAME 8: HOPFIT

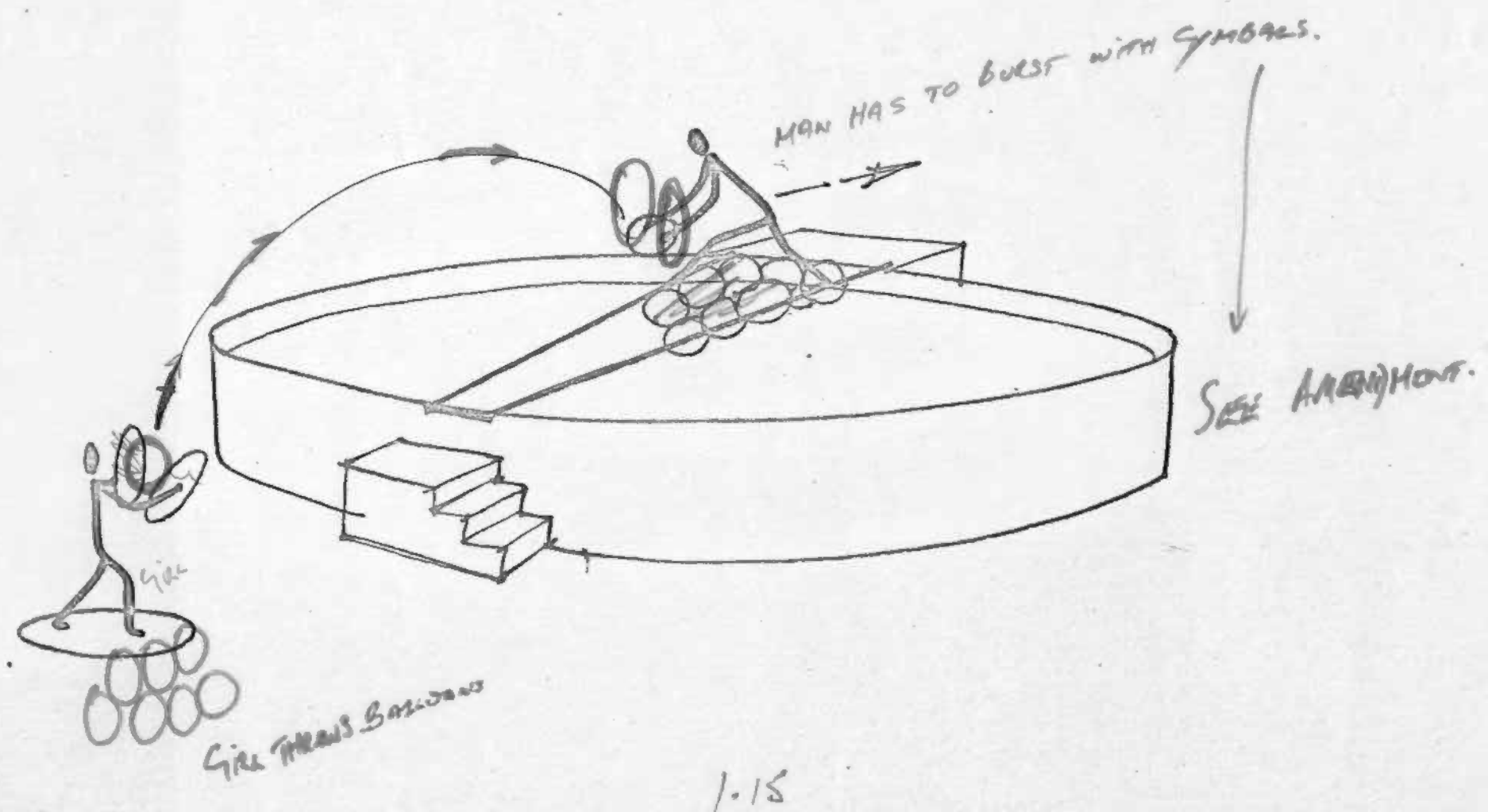

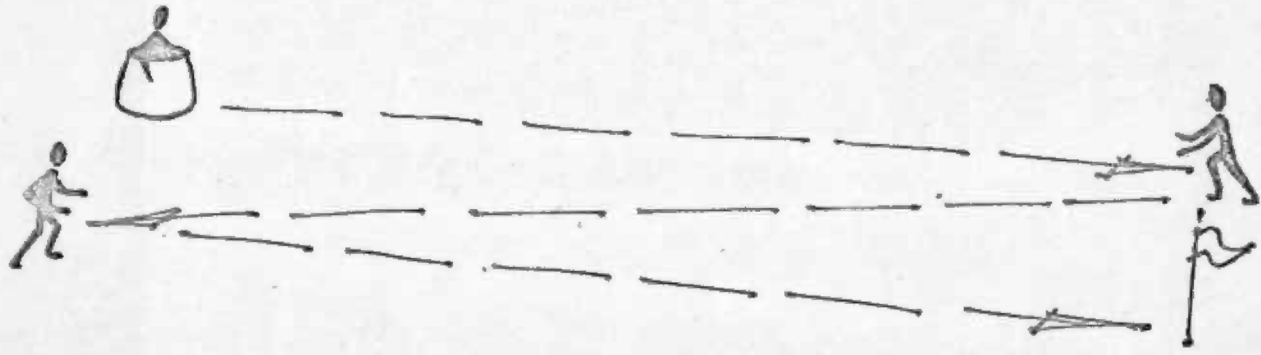
